A wooden cross will be placed in the vestibule near the front door on Sunday, March 17th, and Palm Sunday, March 24th to be used as a Prayer Cross. If you have a need or concern in your heart, you are invited to write your prayer requests on paper that will be provided and

We ask that during the interlude time of the service, as you quietly have silent prayer, that you also take this time to reflect on the pain and suffering leading to the crucifixion of Jesus, as well as the suffering of humanity and the world under sin. As we open ourselves before God, we place our needs, our fears, our failures, our hopes, our very lives in God's hands. We pray that this will be a moving time for reflection and a powerful call to prayer. At the close of our Palm Sunday service, our prayer requests will be removed from the cross and burned, to symbolize releasing our needs to God and to humble ourselves before God, that without Him we are but dust and ashes.

Passover "Seder" Dinner



Highlights from the Board Meeting held on January 17th, 2024

Chairman Tammy Mayo called the bi-monthly board meeting to order and opened with prayer. A silent roll was taken with ten members present.

Tammy Mayo presented the Treasurer's Report prepared by Mary Alice Noel, Treasurer. The Church began with a balance of \$206,678.46 on November 1st. Total receipts were \$26,325.59, total disbursements were \$22,094.50 and \$3,485.06 was in the Givelify account which gives a balance in Regular Checking of \$214,394.61 as of
December 31st, 2023. As for our Designated Funds, we have \$400 in the Food Pantry, \$100 for Bible Study, \$450 for the Cemetery, \$500 for the Building Fund, \$1,425 in the
Samaritan Fund, \$240 for Worship, memorial donations for Lloyd Hicks of \$125 and memorial donations for Norman Rose of \$225 which is a total of \$3,465. The Savings Account has \$13,318.36. The Church has two CDs that total \$100,861.76. Report was accepted.

Jane Harris presented the Cemetery Treasurer's Report dated November 16th, 2023 through January 16th, 2024. The current Principal Amount in a CD (not to be used for upkeep) is \$26,935 with \$700 being held to place in a CD. The current amount in General Checking (to be used for general maintenance for the cemetery) is \$11,837.26. Report was accepted.

Pastor Andy Rose will be giving up the Christian Youth Fellowship in order to start a group at his new church. March 13th will be his last youth group meeting at HGCC. Chairman Tammy has an idea of someone or a couple that could take over. Jane said if it is a married couple, she believes another adult would be needed to satisfy our insurance policy restrictions.

As for the Church property, Jane confirmed that the insurance inspection was completed, and it appears the insurance company will proceed with the policy. We may have a few things to do in order to be in compliance (i.e. fire extinguisher placement). Steve Montgomery confirmed a new flood light was installed on the playground. Dawn Lipscomb asked if the floodlight by the sanctuary/fellowship hall would be relocated by the contractor when the storage room was built. Billy Lloyd stated we would ask them to do so. Billy also said he called the contractor in regard to the depth of the pipe he laid in the ground. It's very shallow and Billy was concerned about the pipes freezing.

The Christian Education Chair still needs to be filled by March 13th.

We still are in need for A/V helpers. Jeff Clough along with Tammy Mayo, Diane Rigsby and Grayton Clough are currently assisting.

Billy confirmed the door closer was installed. He also installed something to hold the front door open.

The Church pamphlet still needs to be updated.

Jane will present to members the cemetery amendment change to the Church Constitution by-laws. UPDATE: Amendment passed by the members.

Billy still has mulch for the playground, and he has gotten a new ladder for the church.

Tammy will be changing the door passcode now that renovations are completed.

Board meetings will be changed to Sundays after church during the winter months.

Most recent electric bill was \$500 which is less expensive than oil.

Tammy adjourned the meeting.
